Cotton Tales

"While housing a refugee family in 'Ukraine, it occurred to me that a crochet hook was something nearly all of these women had in common... Forced out of their homes and/or jobs by the ongoing conflict, each of them has a tale to tell: they are tales of personal tragedy and loss, tales of financial ruin, and tales of ongoing hardship in the midst of an economy in shambles..." Since participating in this project our church has distributed many bunnies, a few tigers and is patiently awaiting the arrival of moose and more bunnies. The unique cloth aprons (for children and adults) are quickly becoming a popular item as well. When you order an item from the Cotton Tales project the majority of your donation goes to the woman who made the item and a portion of it helps to cover other costs associated with the project, such as the cost of materials and shipping. Your donation helps refugee families with basic necessities by providing them with supplemental crochet work. This project also brings refugees into regular contact with local believers who are eager to share the hope they have in Christ with them.

Katey recently expressed her thanks for the part our church has played in helping these refugees. They "have been able to add several more women who are barely scraping by in the war zone to the project recently – in part because of what you are doing."
