RESOURCE CENTER: The Blessing of Humility by Jerry Bridges
We all admire humility when we see it. But how do we practice it? How does humility—the foundational virtue of the normal Christian life—become a normal part of our everyday lives? Jerry Bridges sees in the Beatitudes a series of blessings from Jesus, a pattern for humility in action. Starting with poverty in spirit—an acknowledgment that in and of ourselves we are incapable of living holy lives pleasing to God—and proceeding through our mourning over personal sin, our hunger and thirst for righteousness, our experience of persecutions large and small, and more, we discover that humility is itself a blessing: At every turn, God is present to us, giving grace to the humble and lifting us up to blessing. 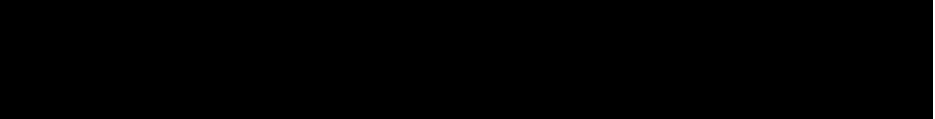

THIS WEEK: MISSION UPDATE

This Tuesday, elder Barry Brooks and I will be travelling to Fortaleza, Brazil, to minister alongside Diego Ramos and his family. This will be the third time our church has sent a team to this region.

The purpose of our church's involvement in Brazil may seem a bit fuzzy to some of you, since it is not a traditional church-planting mission. Here it is, in a nutshell: In the state of Ceara, there exists a network of churches, now in its 3rd generation of existence, originally planted by faithful missionaries from the Kansas City area. These churches are solid in theology because of their missionary legacy, but not because of thorough biblical understanding. There is very little expository preaching and very few ministers trained in the original languages. The overall goal of our involvement there is to complete the work begun by those pioneer missionaries: to help plant a fully-functioning seminary so that the Brazilians can equip their own pastors, teaching them Greek and Hebrew and training them in expository preaching. The goal is for the church in Ceara to be completely independent of outside help and able to reproduce itself elsewhere.

Between eating tropical produce, embarrassing ourselves at soccer, and stumbling over Portuguese phrases, Barry and I will be kept busy. Brazilians are very social people, and we will be constantly engaged with them personally and in groups. Also, the work at the seminary has come to a crossroads at which key decisions must be made; although this is a Brazilian decision, we have been invited into the discussion and desire to be of service.

I will also be speaking at two conferences: First, the Expositor's Bible Conference for pastors, where I'll address the ever-thrilling topic of Replacement Theology in Church History, followed by the Doctrine of Hell and Universalism. The following week, at a conference on hot-button social issues, I'll teach on Abortion, Genetic Engineering, Birth Control, Divorce and Remarriage.

These trips are exhilarating, encouraging, and exhausting. Please pray for us.

- Pray that we would experience and encourage wonderful fellowship with the Brazilians and each other.
- Pray that in the midst of a busy schedule we will take great care to walk in the Spirit and maintain our personal time with the Lord.
- Pray that the Lord uses the Word to bless, challenge, and stimulate our Brazilian brothers and sisters.
- Pray for wisdom, humility, and a sweet spirit of unity in our discussion with key leaders regarding Diego's future ministry.
- Pray for our safety and the safety of our families while we are apart.
